	 Implementation of recognised quality improvement methodologies to continuously develop and improve services, aiming to optimise outcomes for
	 patients Initiation of virtual clinics for medical retina patients as well as for patients
	referred from the diabetic screening service, and additional macular treatment clinics to be initiated at Musgrove Park Hospital
